

## **College Boys Debate.**

The eleventh Shepard prize debate between the Clonian and Phrenocosmian Literary Societies of the College of the City of New-York was held last night in the chapel of the college, Twenty-third Street and Lexington Avenue.

These students represented the two societies: Clonia, L. Levy, '93, and B. G. Paskusz, '94, with Charles Beaubian, '94, as declaimer; Phrenocosmia, J. D. Haney, '93, and William Hirsh, '94, with W. J. Rosenstein, '94, as declaimer.
