Services and Resources on the Library Web Site

The library's web site is a virtual library. It is the most complete source of up-to-date information about the library's services. Use it to find information and to receive many of the same services that you get in the library. Our web site is available on or off campus from any computer connected to the Internet.

- Learn about the library's credit courses and free workshops.** (Points to the 'Credit Courses' link in the 'Services' menu.)
